TOMY PARKER

Tomy joined the United States Marine Corps as a rifleman and was deployed to Sangin, Afghanistan with the 3rd Battalion 5th Marine Regiment. In a late afternoon in December

2010 while on a foot patrol, Tomy stepped on an improvised explosive device (IED) resulting in the amputation of his right leg above the knee, his left leg at the hip, and all of hte fingers on his left hand except his thumb. After injury, Tomy lost his purpose in life and it led him down the long, dark road of substance abuse and incarceration.

Through love, belief, and willpower Tomy has spent the last few years changing his life and chasing positive outlets. He is an adaptive athlete, Vetrepreneur, public speaker, and auctioneer. Tomy also enjoys traveling with his wife Dara and children, volunteering as a boxing coach at a local gym, and helping others by continuing to shatter perceived limitations and stereotypes that people with disabilities "can't do that".
