

Hello Everyone,

Happy New Year!! The new year signifies a fresh start, a chance to turn over a new leaf and perhaps start something new. It is also a time for New Years resolutions. I would like to talk with you about that from a giving perspective. Many of you may be making New Years resolutions related to finance. If you are anything like me and my family, a sizable portion of your monthly budget may come in the form of subscriptions. Here are some common subscription services and their costs:

Netflix: \$7/month Hulu: \$18/month Disney +: \$14/month Amazon Prime Video: \$15/month

Gym Membership: \$50/month (average)

Just think: if each of our 2300 families gave the equivalent of a Netflix subscription, we would have an extra \$193,200 per year for our ministries. If everyone gave the equivalent of Amazon Prime Video, that number would be \$414,000 per year! Every little bit helps, and if a lot of people do a little bit, we can accomplish great things.

In 2025, you will also hear more about our capital campaign. This campaign is geared toward building our campus and providing the facilities that we need for all of our ministries. 


SAY GOODBYE TO THE THOMAS FAMILY
