How to Access: Directly in Blackboard, the Tutor.com link is located on the left-hand side or in the “Tools” section of any course.

**What is my role in tutorial sessions?**

- Arrive to tutorial appointment on time
- Be prepared with a laptop or Ipad (phones do not allow to share screens/files)
- Be prepared with textbook, notebook, class notes, handouts, pen/pencil
- Come prepared with true attempt at assignments – homework or quiz/test questions will not be answered directly; similar examples will be shown.
- Be prepared to be engaged in the session – practicing problems, explaining steps.
