Downeast Black Cherry

(Permanent Gluten Free Line)

Style: Cider Origin: Boston, MA

* deep tart cherry flavor and aroma that is balanced by a smooth, sweet apple cider finish,
5.1% ABV \$7.50/Pint

Guinness Draught

Style: Stout – Irish Dry Origin: Dublin, Ireland

* Cherry, raisin, and roasty malt character with slight cocoa, chocolate, and coffee flavor. A little sourness and subtle vanilla bean notes – Properly Poured on Nitro!
4.2% ABV \$7.50/20 oz glass

New Trail Crisp Lager

Style: Light American Lager Origin: Williamsport, PA

* finest malts, American Noble hops, Pennsylvania mountain water, and lager yeast in perfect balance for a brilliant beer.
4.8% ABV **\$5/20oz Glass – A great Deal!!!!**

Dogfish Raison D’Etre

Style: Belgian Strong Dark Ale Origin: Milton, DE

* A deep, mahogany ale brewed with beet sugar, green raisins, and Belgian-style yeast. Complex and fine
8% ABV \$5.50/ Goblet/10.5 oz

Von C OG Pils

Style:Pilsner Origin: Norristown, PA

* family recipe dating back 6 generations – Schmidt’s – from 2nd and Girard.. Pale American Lager has been built on a base of pale 2-row barley, 6-row barley, and flaked maize to create a beer with light body and very drinkable
4.9% ABV \$6.50/Pint/16 oz

Brouwerij Kestemont 2 year Lambik

Style: Lambic Origin: Oud-Turnhout, Belgium

*lambic aged 2 years that has a murky copper appearance, and a taste profile of tartness, yeast, and sourdough.
6% ABV \$6.50/Goblet/10.5 oz

Tonewood Fuego

Style: Hazy IPA Origin: Oaklyn, NJ

* golden, hazy IPA with a soft and sweet bread and biscuity malt backbone and up-front aromas of zesty grapefruits, lemons, peaches, and mangos, rounded out by an earthy and floral drag of resinous pine sap. Made right across the river – 7 miles away!!
6.2% ABV \$7.50/Pint

Bear Republic Racer 5

Style: West Coast IPA Origin: Cloverdale, CA

* brewed with malted barley, wheat, and crystal malts. The malt base is designed to highlight the unique floral qualities of Columbus and Cascade hops from the Pacific Northwest.
7.5% ABV \$7.50/Pint/16oz

Maine Lunch

Style: American IPA Origin: Freeport, ME

* East Coast version of a West Coast-style IPA. Intense hop flavors and aromas of tropical and citrus fruits and pine dominate. A subtle malt sweetness balances the beer
7% ABV \$8/Pint/16oz

Lucky Cat Prognosticator

Style: Dopperbock Origin: Bensalem, PA

* A dark German-style dopperbock that drinks clean and complex with a dark Vienna and Munich malt character
8.7% ABV \$6/Pint/16oz

Russian River Pliny the Elder

Style: Imperial/Double IPA Origin: Guerneville, CA

* The Legend – IYKYK
7.5% ABV \$6.50/Goblet/10.5 oz

Brasserie-Brouwerij Cantillon Saint Lamvinus

Style: Lambic Origin: Brussels, Belgium

* blend of lambics aged 16-18 months on Merlot Grapes from Côtés de Bourg in Bordeaux barrels. The end result is a tannin laced Lambic with intense fruit characteristics.
5% ABV \$10.50/Goblet/10 oz

Brasserie-Brouwerij Cantillon Classic Gueuze

Style: Lambic – Gueuze Origin: Brussels, Belgium

* blend of one, two, and three year-old lambics. Fermented only with wild airborne yeasts from the Senne Valley in Brussels and aged in centuries-old oak casks
5% ABV \$9.50/Goblet/10 oz

Breckenridge Vanilla Porter

Style: Porter Origin: Littleton, CO

* Aromas of vanilla and toasted grain set the stage for mellow flavors of vanilla and dark roasted malts
5.4% ABV \$6/Pint/16oz

Cartesian Farmhouse Dubbel

Style: Belgian Dubbel Origin: Philadelphia, PA

* Rustic, with notes of caramel, and spices with a dry but rich finish. Made with 100% PA malt from Deer Creek and Double Eagle fermented with a farmhouse yeast.
7% ABV \$6.50/Pint/16oz

Brouwerij Het Nest SchuppenBoer Tripel

Style: Belgian Triple Origin: Oud-Turnhout, Belgium

* Famous Tripel beer from Flanders. Unique & bold with a fruity aroma, soft bitterness and slightly spicy aftertaste
8.8% ABV \$6.50/Goblet/10.5 oz
